Vicia sativa

Purpose & Fit

Cahaba vetch was bred as a winter forage in southern climates and is a nitrogen fixer with some nematicide properties. With less growth than other vetches, Cahaba vetch won't take over the sward, allowing for more versatility in forage systems.

Growth Pattern

With a white bloom, cahaba vetch can grow to be between eighteen and twenty inches tall.
